To deem our application complete, Kane County is asking us to obtain a Road Use Agreement from affected jurisdictions in conjunction with approval of a **special use permit** for Big Timber Solar Farm, proposed for the SEC of the intersection of Big Timber Road (County 21) and Illinois 72 (Higgins Rd). A copy of the site plan is attached.

We have not initiated construction drawings pending the outcome of the forthcoming approval process. We are not planning on any access roads or driveways onto IL 72 and to the best of our knowledge, any construction traffic will not exceed typical limits for IL ROW's. We are providing for a 75' half width and additional setbacks to meet KC requirements.

In response to the County, can you tell us...

- (1) Is such an agreement required by IDOT without any vehicular access provided to the ROW?
- (2) If the agreement is required, can you provide a link to the correct form to start the process?
