

Dear Mr. Berkout,

I am writing to formally request the postponement of the upcoming meeting regarding the Reimagine property on Big Rock, IL, located on Jericho Rd. Due to the upcoming holiday, many residents and board members will be unavailable, which could hinder effective participation and discussion.

There are several concerns within our community that warrant thorough consideration before proceeding with any decisions. These include issues related to slow-moving tractors and farm equipment, lack of lighting on the road, absence of parking along the roadway and on the property, and the large number of people attending camp activities.

Additionally, there are significant concerns about the request for tax-exempt status, which is viewed unfavorably in Big Rock as part of our efforts to protect our 2030 farmland preservation plan. Further issues include the need for a traffic study, unclear information about the nature of the company involved—whether it is educational, religious, or a for-profit camp—and inconsistencies in the reported size of events and vehicle numbers relative to a farm area. Noise from large gatherings and safety concerns due to a blind spot on the curve near the property also contribute to community apprehensions.

Given these complexities and community concerns, I respectfully propose rescheduling the meeting for one or two weeks later. This delay will allow sufficient time for board members and residents to attend, review relevant information, and share their concerns effectively. Thank you for your understanding and consideration. I look forward to your response.
