Please see the attached request for a "No Permit Required" letter for the above referenced site located in Sugar Grove, Kane County, Illinois. The proposed work on this property is the construction of three 5 MWac community solar facilities. The project will deliver electricity to the grid through three points of interconnection (POIs) with the local electric utility, ComEd. Clean Field Power has conducted significant environmental due diligence over the past six months which has informed the development plan. The project footprints will avoid all wetlands on-site and will incorporate stormwater management practices in compliance with the Kane County Stormwater Management Ordinance.
